

# Degree Works Guide for **Illinois Tech** Coursera Learners

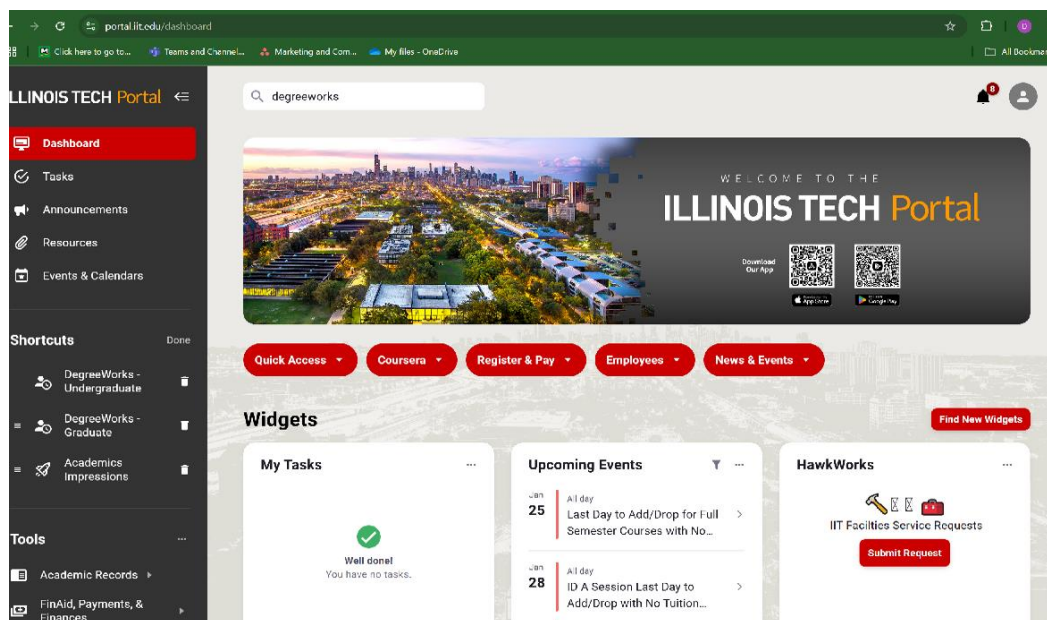

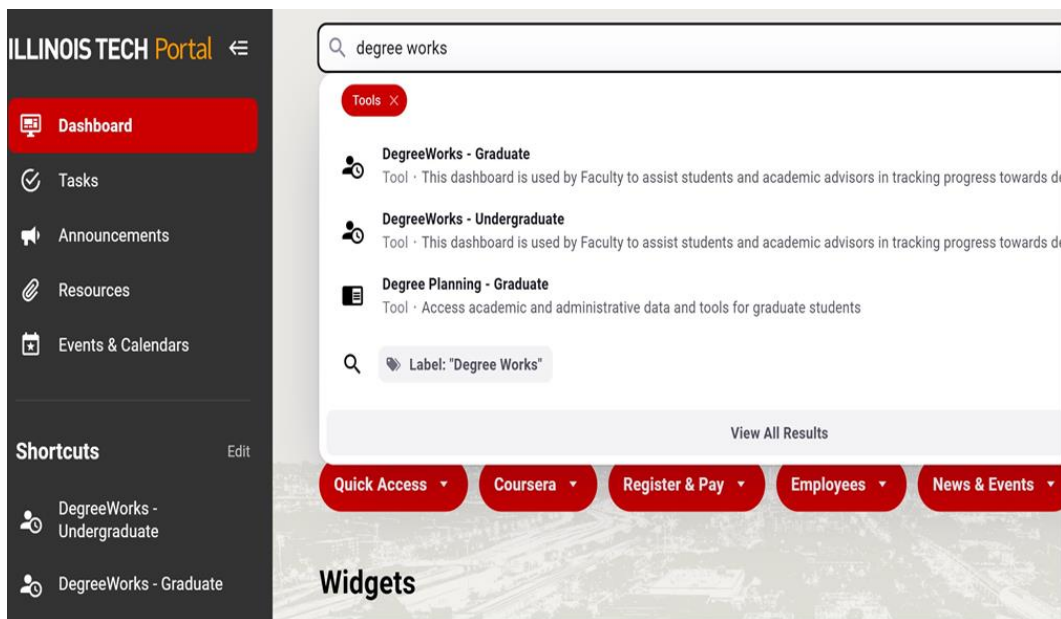
- View your current registrar report

## How to Access Degree Works

To access Degree Works, you will need to do the following:

- Log into the [Illinois Tech Portal](#) and select the Dashboard to view academic information.
- For Illinois Tech Coursera learners, you will type in DegreeWorks to access the unofficial audit tool.





- Graduate students will then select the **DegreeWorks - Graduate**.
- Undergraduate students will select the **DegreeWorks - Undergraduate**.
